

## BROW POST PROCEDURE CARE

Please remember that permanent makeup does not replace regular cosmetics. If you prefer to have more noticeable eyebrows, you can enhance the effect by dyeing your hair (using hair dye or henna) with a color that complements your permanent makeup.

It's quite common for clients to feel like there is hardly anything left after the procedure. Let us assure you that the remaining amount is intentional. Your safety is our utmost priority. If the implanted pigment is too bright, it may develop an unpleasant shade as it fades. We all know those unwanted colors: RED, GREEN, and BLUE.

### FIRST 1-2 DAYS

- Do not soak.
- Do not touch with dirty hands.
- Wash with soapy water (to remove lymphatic fluids).
- Moisturize with Depanthenol (does not heal, but restores and soothes).

### FIRST WEEK

- Do not apply decorative cosmetics to the treatment zone.
- Do not peel off.
- Limit sports activities.

### FIRST MONTH

- Refrain from prolonged water activities, such as sauna, bath and pool.
- Refrain from heavy impact sports.
- During this period, refrain from cosmetic procedures, such as masks, peels and injections.

***ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS:*** Always protect the treatment area (whether newly treated or not). Subsequent touch-up treatments are recommended at least once after eight months and a year and a half.

# BROW TREATMENT STAGES

## IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE PROCEDURE

After the procedure, the pigment remains on the surface of the skin, forming a protective barrier and enhancing the brightness by 30-50% compared to the final result.

## HEALED

After exfoliation, an invisible transparent protective film remains (particles of keratinized epidermis) which dims the color.

## ONE MONTH LATER

After complete regeneration, renewed cells bring out the color.

## POST CORRECTION TREATMENT

We add another portion to the already existing pigment, thereby saturating the color and ensuring continued effect.

## ONE YEAR LATER

With the skilled technician and a proper care by the client, as time goes by the shade of the color that was originally implanted, loses saturation.

# BROW HEALING PROCESS



## *IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE PROCEDURE*

- In the first hour after the procedure, clients can experience a burning or tingling sensation;
- Swelling may remain for up to 3 hours.

## *4-5 DAYS AFTER THE PROCEDURE*

- The peeling stage begins: part of the pigment disappears with the peeling crusty particles of the epidermis.

## *6-7 DAYS AFTER THE PROCEDURE*

- Full exfoliation.

## *28-30 DAYS AFTER THE PROCEDURE*

- After the completion of the regeneration process, the final color sets in.

## *CORRECTION*

- The final stage of the primary procedure to correct color, symmetry, shape and saturation.
